

School Psychologist Intern Posting

Opening for full time Psychologist Intern for the district for the 2017-2018 school year. This position provides internship opportunities for third year School Psychology graduate students working towards a MA or Ed.S. in school psychology. Must have a four year degree in behavioral/social sciences and graduate work in educational psychology and assessment. Must show evidence of eligibility for an intern position.

Primary responsibilities include but are not limited to: Collaborate with staff to provide for the needs of students, provide educational assessment and interpretation of the assessment in the special education process and related programs, provide developmental counseling and crisis intervention assistance under the supervision of the District Psychologist and Director of Exceptional Student Services. Act as a liaison to the home, school and community to support plans and strategies for individual students. Maintain accurate and complete records required by law and school district policy. Performing other duties and responsibilities as assigned by the School Psychology Internship Supervisor and the Director of Special Education.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE: Active enrollment in an accredited School Psychology graduate program and completion of all other course requirements (usually third year students). The internship year requires a minimum of 1200 hours of supervised work in the field.
